**Athletic Hall of Fame**

The Hall of Fame will recognize outstanding athletes, coaches, and other outstanding individuals who have made significant contributions to Towson's athletic program. Each inductee will receive a plaque to be displayed in the "Avenue of Excellence" hallway of Towson High School commemorating his/her contributions and/or achievements while participating in or working for the Towson High School Athletic Program.

Athletes will become eligible seven years after graduating from Towson, while coaches, administrators, volunteers and other individuals may become eligible after retirement from coaching or their involvement with the school.

The nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to his or her sport while attending Towson. This may include recognition as All-County, All-Metro, All-State, All-American, school record holder, and other notable honors. The nominee must exemplify outstanding qualities of character and sportsmanship while representing Towson and also throughout the years following graduation. The nominee should serve as a positive role model, worthy of being emulated by students, both current and in the future. In the event that an inducted individual becomes unworthy of this honor, they can be removed from the Hall of Fame.

The nomination form must be submitted to the athletic director where they shall be kept on file for five years. Nominees not selected may be reconsidered for a subsequent induction class. After five years, an individual may be renominated with a new nomination form. The Hall of Fame Committee will review all nominees by March 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. This committee shall consist of at least 7 members to include (but not limited to) the current school principal, current Athletic Director, the Sports Boosters President (or designee), the Towson High School Alumni Association President (or designee), current or past coaches/athletic directors who have served or coached at least 10 head varsity athletic seasons at Towson High School. The committee will meet annually and make selections for induction during a special designated athletic event.

The selection and induction into Towson's Hall of Fame shall be limited to 5 individuals per year.

The Nomination Form is attached. Announcements and notices for solicitation of nominees will be communicated through the local newspapers, school and booster web sites, the PTSA news letter, at homecoming, and class reunions. The nomination form will be published as a link to the athletic department website ([www.towsonathletics.digitalsports.com](http://www.towsonathletics.digitalsports.com)), along with the nomination and selection requirements.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES and FORM**

Nominations for Towson High School's Athletic Hall of Fame can be made by using the following criteria:

1. An athlete must have graduated from Towson High School a minimum of 7 years prior to nomination. A coach is eligible upon retirement from active coaching and/or teaching. All other individuals will use the same waiting period.
2. The nominee should have made an outstanding contribution to his / her sport. This may include the attainment of All-County, All-Metropolitan, All-State, All-American, school record holder, and other notable accomplishments while an athlete at Towson.
3. Any nominee should also have been a solid citizen and an exemplary person while representing Towson. The nominee should have maintained the same qualities after graduation. The nominee should be able to serve as a positive role model, one worthy of being emulated by current and future students.

Selection process:

1. Complete the form below and attach a supportive paragraph, along with pertinent statistical material and information. Feel free to submit additional information that you believe will be supportive of your nominee.
2. The nominations should be sent to the Athletic Director at Towson High School.
3. An individual's nomination will remain on file for five years.
4. The Hall of Fame Committee will review all nominations.
5. Selection and induction to Towson High School's Athletic Hall of Fame shall be limited to 5 inductees in any one year.
