## Oosterling-Moyer Inducted in HOF

The one thing you could say about Ellen-Oosterling Moyer '54 is that her list of accomplishments would not fit on one page, let alone one column. She was inducted into the Towson High Alumni Association's "Hall of Fame" in due to her outstanding involvement in the community, as well as the work place. Currently she holds the position of mayor of Annapolis, being the first woman to ever do so. That is just par for the course, for someone who has worked for the community for four decades. From District Director of the Girl Scouts of America in the 50's, to Teaching 5th grade in the 60's, to Executive Director for the Maryland Commission for Women in the 70's, her jobs have been many- her resume long. It is certainly difficult to list all of Ms. Moyer's accomplishments here in the pages of the Newsnote, but here are some highlights:

- Director of Government Relations for the Maryland State Teachers Association (MSTA) for over 20 years.
- Helped to bring gifted and talented programs to Maryland Schools.
- Helped to facilitate the organization of spousal abuse shelters.
- Initiated Greenscape, which is a community volunteer program, now in its seventh year.
- Founding member of Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, a regional education and arts center.



Among these accomplishments Ms. Moyer is also involved with many organizations like the Forest Conservation Committee, Annapolis Conservancy Board, Maryland Land Trust Alliance, Coordinating Committee for Clean and Beautiful Annapolis as well as, Anne Arundel Arts Association, Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Annapolis Summer Garden Theatre and the committee to bring a culture and education center to Annapolis.

After graduating from Towson High, Ms. Moyer received her B.A. from Pennsylvania State in Liberal Arts, as well as a M.ED from Goucher College and a M.S.W. from University of Maryland. Her list of awards and recognitions is long and impressive,

including Citizen of the Year (from MD Citizen Action) and Doctor Emeritus (from the MD State Board of Education). Congratulations Mayor Moyer, we should all have a life filled with so much dedication and perseverance!

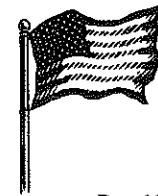
