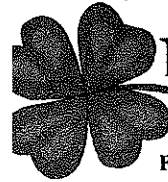

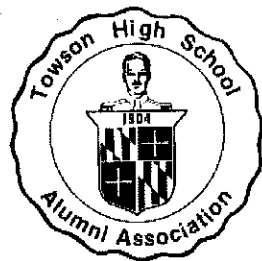

## TOWSON HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Do you know any classmates that you think would qualify for the Towson High School Alumni Hall of Fame? Here are the criteria, as clarified by the members of the Hall of Fame Committee:

- Except under mitigating circumstances, the candidate must be a graduate of Towson High School.
- The candidate must be a person of good character and reputation in his professional and personal life; a person who can be considered a role model for future generations.
- In addition, the candidate must be assayed under one or more of the following categories:

The candidate must be a leader in his community, showing substantial and/or long-term contributions in such capacity, particularly as a volunteer.

A business/professional candidate shall have reached prominence in his business life; a position as may be considered a top echelon position and unique among his professional peers.

An academic/professional candidate shall have succeeded beyond others in his field by way of contribution and by reaching national or international prominence among his peers.

An artistic or literary candidate shall have a body of work considered by critics and his peers to have gained national and/or international prominence in his art and/or performance.

It should be noted that, at the discretion of the Hall of Fame Committee and favorable acceptance by the Executive Committee, worthy candidates under other criteria than those listed here may be considered by comparison of such contributions to outstanding contributions by others in the same field of endeavor.

If a candidate is not selected at first nomination, additional information may be requested by the committee to be added to the nominee's file for future consideration. Please submit nominees to the alumni post office box.
