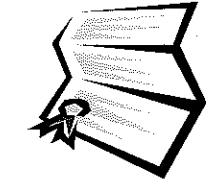

A Letter from the President...

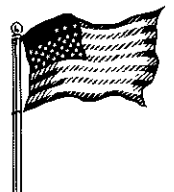

The Towson High School Alumni Association's mission is: "To assist in the maintenance of Towson High School's tradition of educational excellence by encouraging its graduates to continue their interest in its programs, in the maintenance of its facilities, and in continuance of its development of citizens having skills and intellectual resources which reflect well on them and their school." In our efforts to meet the objectives of this mission, we are asking for your help. This is my second (non-consecutive) term as president. In 1998-1999, we were able to make significant changes in the organization's operations and communications efforts. Specifically, we implemented internal controls to make sure we were acting with the highest of fiduciary standards. We also were able to transition our database from a DOS format to a more useable Windows format. In addition, we built a website, www.towsonhighalumni.org, that evidences ever increasing functionality.

During my second term, our goal is to help our high school compete at the highest levels of academics, athletics and the arts. Every state in our nation is facing severe financial difficulties. This comes at a time that more of our young people need financial and other support.

In order to provide the necessary technological infrastructure, books, maps, music and art supplies, lights for our athletic fields and scholarships, we want to increase our Ted Prince Memorial Scholarship Fund to the point that the fund itself could support all of these efforts with interest alone. Thus, we are initiating an Annual Fund Campaign. You will be receiving a separate letter describing this campaign. We are counting on you to support our efforts in making Towson High, your high school, an *Excellent High School*.

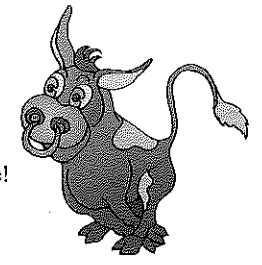
