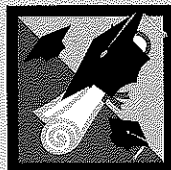

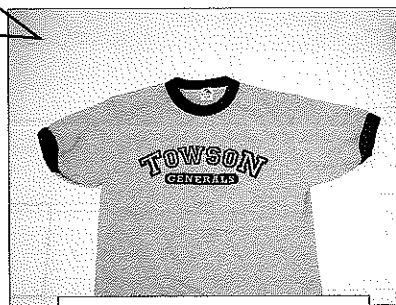

October 13, 2007 was an exciting day for a group of alumni who organized a celebration to mark the 100th anniversary of the founding of the Towson High School Alumni Association. The Centennial Committee, comprised of alumni who live at Oak Crest, were led by Chairwoman Deane Clark Laycock '37. They worked for over a year planning the event and were rewarded with a turnout of more than 240 alumni and guests! Attendees were able to browse through a large memorabilia display provided by THSAA. There were pictures of Towson's sports teams ranging from the 1926 Track team to Michael Phelps! Yearbooks, a display dedicated to alumni who perished in WW II, an old "dance card" and even the Senior Prom "beverage" steins were among the many treasured pieces of history.

The Master of Ceremonies for the day, McCarl Roberts '49, told jokes and even did a few magic tricks while keeping the whole event flowing! Several dignitaries were on hand with special presentations to THSAA; State Senators Katherine Klausmeier and James Brochin with a Resolution from the Maryland Senate, a representative for County Executive Jim Smith with an Executive Citation and Ms. Pat Foerster, Education Policy Advisor for the Office of Governor O'Malley with a Governor's Citation. We were all pleasantly surprised by the outstanding recognition of THS throughout our State!

Assistant Secretary of State, Ellen Sauerbrey '55, reflected on her times at Towson and as a Hall of Fame Inductee, keeps her award in her office as a fond remembrance of her educational roots. Additional speeches about the Association's history and current school accomplishments were given by Mrs. Jane Barranger, THS Principal, and Terri Bowers Smith '84, President of THSAA.

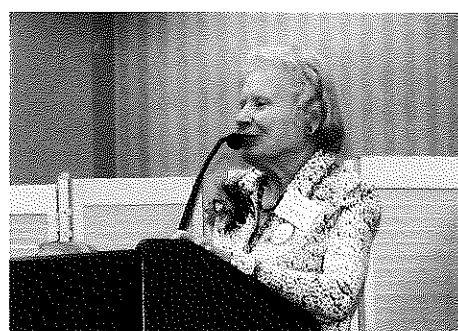
