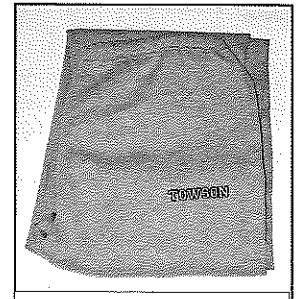

"In light of Veterans Day, Towson Alums inspire greatness"

One of the most controversial wars in American history: anti-war protests, impeachment threats, billion dollar budgets. The Iraq War? Try again— think back forty-nine years ago to the beginning of the infamous Vietnam War.

Tom Middaugh and Dick Laurance, two Towson High School Alumni, both served in the Vietnam War. Their stories bring new light to a history lesson that can seem faded with time.

Tom Middaugh, graduating class of 1958, was a captain in the 11th Armored Cavalry Unit. He went to college at the United States Military Academy at West Point and signed up in 1968 for a year long tour.

Middaugh's experience in the army was different from that of the average soldier's. He planned troop movements and directed defense strategies. In the mortuary, he says he "identified soldiers of the 11th Cavalry Unit. But my unit was unusually lucky, with only several hundred killed out of the 30,000 people (in the 11th Cavalry)."

Only twice in his year long tour of duty did he get to take a three day vacation to Vong Tao, and a five day trip to Australia. Despite this, Middaugh felt that being part of the army was worth it.

"Being a soldier is one of the noblest positions in life," Middaugh states. "The best thing I ever did was (enter the army), because my whole life wan't about me." He also points out the tremendous growth in character that soldiers experience upon entering the army. "Soldiers will do their hardest (for the army): you can tell them to go tot their death and they will do it."

Richard Laurance, also class of 1958, agrees. "(The military) was trhe best thing I ever did. In the military you grow up pretty quick....suddenly you're on your own." Laurance entered the service as a member of the Construction Battalion, working in engineering for the war effort. He constructed Mobile Army Surgical Headquarters (MASH) units, orphanages and air fields. His tour was more intermittent than Middaugh's, as he spent several month-long intervals in Vietnam from 1965 to 1967, in addition to serving short week-long tours from '68-70.

Both men were involved in the persuasion of the Vietnamese people to American ideals. "We wanted to turn the hearts and minds of the people," comments Middaugh. Laurance says, "Our job was to provide facilities and to get the Vietnamese people over to the American side by civil action."

Both experienced the typical anxieties felt by soldiers at war. They missed their families, their homes, and worried about day-to-day life. Of course, day-to-day worries for a soldier are a little more severe than the average citizen's. "There isn't a soldier who doesn't think, "Gosh, I wonder if I'm going to be alive tomorrow," Middaugh says. "(As a captain), it's hard, when you're telling people to stick their lives out on the line, to be buddies with them."

Although fifty years separates the men of the Vietnam War from THS' current generation, the politics that dominated their teenage years are very similar to those facing the nation at this time. Men who walked THS' halls went o to protect our country and the way they represented their country is inspiring. Only time will tell if the effects of the Iraq War will change and shape the men of today like the Vietnam War molded these Towson High graduates.

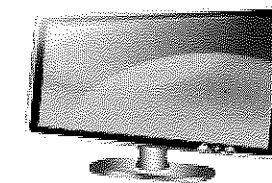

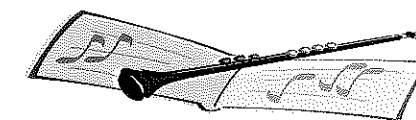
