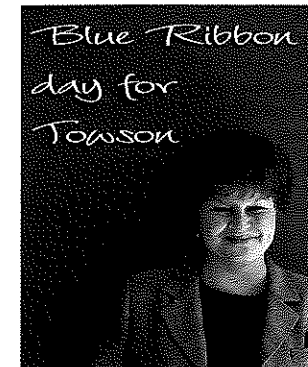

## Towson High Declared a Blue Ribbon School!



State Superintendent of Schools, Nancy S. Grasmick, announced on December 17, 2010 that Towson High would join the elite group of Maryland Blue Ribbon Schools. Towson is the 15<sup>th</sup> Baltimore County school and only the 3<sup>rd</sup> high school to receive such an honor. Blue Ribbon School designation is a state and national program that recognizes schools that meet rigorous standards developed by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) and the U.S. Department of Education.

On February 10th, State and County officials celebrated at THS as part of Grasmick's "Tour of Excellence." Dr. Jane Barranger, THS Principal, (pictured on left) led the ceremony and County Executive Kevin Kamenetz presented the school with an executive citation.

So what does Dr. Barranger have to say about this latest accomplishment? "You've earned it!" she announced to the school. "The Blue Ribbon award is a great validation of our faculty and staff and their commitment to our students. I stand in awe of them." Asked to explain the school's success, Principal Barranger

said, "It is a focus on common goals through the school system's Blueprint for Progress that enables us to cut through any distractions and focus on the needs of the students." She continued, "At Towson High, the magic happens in the classrooms on a daily basis. What we offer our students as instruction has to be interesting and has to be challenging. The achievements of our school and our school system validate that more kids can succeed and that by adopting that philosophy as a country, we will be better off."

Towson's accomplishments are many; 17% of THS seniors rank in the top 5% of the students in Maryland, students are 99% proficient in English and 98% proficient in Math, 76% of THS students take the SAT and THS ranked 334<sup>th</sup> in Newsweek's 2010 "America's Best High Schools" list. Also this past year, the school had seven National Merit Finalists and 26 National Commended Students - in addition to three National Achievement Scholarship Finalists, one National Hispanic Recognition Scholar, 38 Maryland Distinguished Scholars in Academic and Visual Arts, and 68 seniors who were Advanced Placement Scholars. Towson has had more than 9 million dollars awarded to students in grants and scholarships this past year alone! Pretty impressive for our *alma mater*! Here are some more noteworthy accomplishments of current teachers and students:

#### Teachers:

- **Cheryl Milligan**, Art Department Chair, was presented with the "National Secondary Art Educator of the Year Award" by the National Art Education Association in March 2011.
- **Glenn Hyman**, Math Department Chair, was awarded "High School Math Teacher of the Year" by the Maryland Council on Teachers of Mathematics in Sept, 2010.
- **Randy Dase, '72**, Social Studies teacher, has hosted "High School Sports Scene" for 25 years!

#### Students:

- **Nico Sarbanes, '11**, was selected for the All Eastern Jazz Ensemble.
- **Diana Reighart, '12, and Will Fesperman, '11**, along with their teacher, Frank Fitzgibbon, attended the initiation of a major sequencing project at JHU this summer. Their AP Biology Class has been working on "Duckweed & DNA Sequences" through Rutgers Waksman Student Scholar program with Johns Hopkins as a satellite partner. Students, as a class, will assemble a trifold to present at a JHU symposium in late April 2011.
- **Casey Ivanauskas, '11**, has been selected as a Page for the Maryland General Assembly.
- **Molly Broom, '11, Annie Bishai, '11, and Emma Popp, '10**, had artwork selected and displayed in "Maryland High School Artists: A Juried Exhibit" at the U.S. Department of Education in Washington D.C. in October, 2010.
- **Will Fesperman, '11**, was selected as a YoungArts Finalist in Poetry at the Annual National YoungArts Competition sponsored by the National Foundation for Advancement in Arts.
- **27 students** were selected to participate in the Baltimore County Public Schools Honor Band, Chorus, and Orchestra concert at the Joseph Meyerhoff Symphony Hall on November 15, 2010.

The celebration has not stopped...in March, THS will be honored along with the other five Blue Ribbon schools chosen this year at a banquet in Annapolis. Towson will be recognized with a tribute by the Maryland General Assembly. Each school chosen this year will receive over \$6,000 in technology equipment from Smart Technologies, \$1,000 from MSDE and its corporate sponsors and a pizza party from Joe Corbi's Pizza!

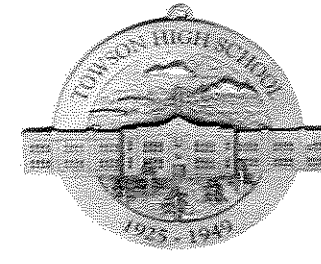

# From the Talisman

## THS Traditions Change Over Time

Dating back to its founding in 1873, Towson High School has changed considerably over the years. From its students, faculty and stone structure, THS has seen a wide array of changes. However, some of the most notable changes have taken place with school traditions.

Towson has always had events whose main activity focused on dancing. One such tradition is Towson's Ring Dance. Of her ring dance experience, school Secretary and THS alumna, Alison (Bonner) Beatty, '87, states, "I was nervous."

For Beatty, back in 1985, Ring Dance was an event for the junior class, as opposed to today, where it is a sophomore class event. Additionally, a large ring was placed in the center of the dance floor and students would meet their date in the middle, then exchange rings and a kiss. Beatty suspects that, due to the anxiety felt by the students, the tradition was done away with.

Similarly, the pep rallies have undergone many changes over the years. THS Social Studies teacher and alumnus, Mr. Randall Dase, '72, recalls that the pep rallies, held for most Towson-Dulaney games, were an exciting tradition during his high school years.

"They were great; they were awesome," states Dase about THS pep rallies.

The four classes joined together in the auditorium for music provided by the THS band, as well as for games and activities

organized by the Student Government Association (SGA). According to Dase, the players found support in not only the fans' cheers, but in the enthusiasm brought by the General mascot. These days the mascot is rarely seen. Additionally, during Dase's tenure as a student, many of the cheerleaders would cheer for as many sports as possible, not just for the big events like football.

In addition to the sport changes, Social Studies teacher, Mr. Gilbert Stange, '82, remembers Senior Dress up Day. The day was devoted to dressing up for fun. He recalls sporting coast guard attire with his friends and holding the teachers captive. While the hijinx were harmless back then, such acts of silliness would be relegated to student to student interactions.

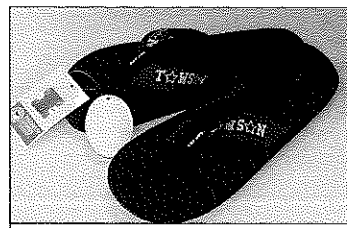
The senior lawn photo which is taken every April and has seniors standing in the shape of the number of their graduating year, still remains a Towson tradition. However, the location of these pictures has changed. The original senior photos were taken of the students standing on the side hill to the left of the Cedar Avenue entrance which is now home to the air conditioning unit. Now, the photos are taken in the open space near the science wing close to the soccer field.

The beginning and end of all Spirit Weeks have stayed the same as well. The start of the week has always been Maroon and White Day as students are always seen sporting their school colors to demonstrate their school pride. At the end of the week, students will always wear their class colors for the pep rally.

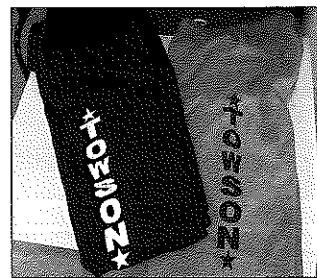
Although many traditions have changed, some have stayed because some are like that old saying, "If it ain't broke, don't fix it."

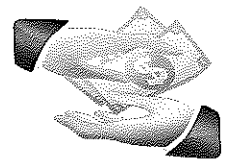

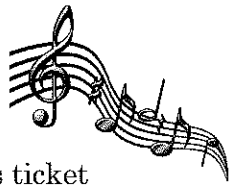
