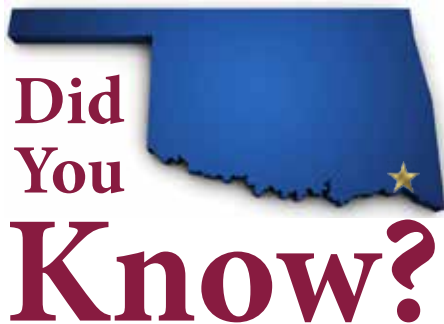

# In Memoriam

## Ellison W. Ensor

Student and THSAA Hall of Fame  
Died March 18th, 2016 at the age of 98.



**Ellison Ensor** graduated from Towson High in 1936. After graduation he met and married fellow student Mildred Cox '37. They married in 1939. In 1941, Ensor began what was to become a long and successful career with the Baltimore County Police Department. Starting as a Patrolman he rose to become a Corporal, Sargent, Lieutenant, Chief Inspector, Captain and finally, the Chief of Police in 1967. He served as Chief until his retirement in 1975. ## Bruce A. Hart

Teacher and Coach 1971 to 1973  
Died March 22, 2016 at the age of 70.



**Bruce Hart** taught Physical Education and coached Football and Lacrosse from 1971 to 1973. He came to Towson High after serving in the United States Army and after graduating from Towson State University. After leaving Towson he took a job with Harford County Schools and started their interscholastic Lacrosse

program. In 1978 he left the school system and took a full-time, active duty position with the National Guard, advancing to Lieutenant Colonel Brevet. In 1984, on his way home from work, he was hit by a speeding car which left him a quadriplegic. His accomplishments and accolades in the years to follow are both impressive and numerous.
